- **July 29, 1975:** "School Superintendent Wants to Meet People"

"The first opportunity for the new School District 7 superintendent, Dr. DeRand Jones, to meet a group of area residents in a social situation was the recent reception given for him and his wife, Dr. Gail Jones, at the Robert Holzgang home.

"Hostesses were Marge Holzgang, chairman of the Rogue Community College Board, and Sue (Mrs. Phil) Nelson of the District 7 School board. ..."
