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## **Free Naloxone training offered at RCC campuses in Medford, White City**

Rogue Community College's counseling department, in collaboration with Max's Mission, will offer free community workshops on Naloxone, a life-saving medication that can reverse the effects of an opioid overdose.

Each workshop will teach participants what Naloxone is, how it works, how to use it and where to find it locally.

Every attendee will receive an information packet and a Naloxone kit to take home.

Naloxone, also known by the brand name Narcan, is a medication designed to rapidly reverse opioid overdose. It is safe, easy to use and available without a prescription in many areas.

Naloxone workshops will be offered at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 7, in Room 132 at the RCC/SOU Higher Education Center, Riverside Campus, 101 S. Bartlett St., Medford; and at 11 a.m. Monday, Oct. 13, in Room 184 of the A building on the Table Rock Campus, 7800 Pacific Ave., White City.
